NOTE:

Officially: "Rincon del Diablo a San Gregorio". This route starts in Escondido and treks over the hills to the desert town of Borrego Springs (near San Gregorio) before climbing back toward the coast. Most of Escondido occupies the former Rancho Rincon del Diablo. This "Devil's Corner" was a Mexican land grant given to Juan Bautista Alvarado in 1843 by the Governor. Members of the first Anza expedition camped at the Kumeyaay Indians village in March, 1774. The Spaniards called this village (and spring) just east of the Borrego Sink, San Gregorio. It is the location of the original Borrego Spring.
