| 0.2 | Turn left onto E Mission Rd | 3 |
| 3.2 | L - N Las Posas Rd | 0.8 |
| 4 | R - Linda Vista Dr | 1 |
| 5 | L - To continue on Linda Vista Dr | 1 |
| 6 | L - Poinsettia Ave | 0.4 |
| 6.4 | L - Business Park Dr | 0.2 |
| 6.6 | R - Palomar Airport Rd | 2.3 |
| 8.9 | L - El Camino Real | 3.2 |

| 30.5 | R -Down-ramp to Gilman Dr. (<i>Steep & Fast!</i>) | 0.1 |
| 30.6 | R - Gilman Dr | 1.6 |
| 32.2 | BR - After passing under I-5, enter marked Rose Canyon Bicycle Path at sidewalk. Path continues onto Santa Fe St. | 3.1 |
| 35.3 | R - Damon Ave | 0.2 |
| 35.5 | S - Cross Mission Bay Dr. and enter marked Rose Creek Trail other side. (<i>Use light button to cross if necessary</i>) Lumpy, bumpy Trail passes under 2 roadways ahead. | 0.9 |
| 36.4 | L - N Mission Bay Dr. Follow around Bay. | 2.8 |
| 39.2 | S - Cross Sea World Dr. Road B/C Pacific Hwy. | 0.6 |
| 39.8 | R - After crossing bridge, turn RIGHT to enter marked Ocean Beach Bike Path westward. Path passes under 3 roadways ahead. | 2.4 |
| 42.2 | L - At park, exit OB Bike Path (<i>sign</i>) | - |
| 42.2 | R - Bacon St | 0.4 |
| 42.6 | OCEAN BEACH CONTROL: 7-Eleven, 2190 Bacon St., San Diego, CA. (OPEN:+2:18 – CLOSE:+4:36) Obtain proof of passage with time & date stamp. | - |
| 42.6 | L - Bacon St. (Reverse route) | 0.3 |
| 42.9 | L - Enter Ocean Beach Bike Path eastward | 0.5 |
| 43.4 | L - At Sunset Cliffs Blvd., enter bikeway across SD River Channel. | 0.2 |
| 43.6 | L - Exit bikeway. loop under Sunset Cliffs Blvd. & follow Old Sea World Dr. trail eastward along SD River Channel. | 1.2 |
| 44.8 | L - Use light-button to cross Sea World Dr. onto S. Shores Park Dr. | 0.3 |
| 45.1 | R - At parking lot, enter marked bike path. Follow around bay. | 0.7 |
| 45.8 | L - At Fiesta Island Rd. turn LEFT and follow Mission Bay Dr. northward around bay. You are now on a reverse route course. | 2.7 |

| 65.7 | R - Chesterfield Dr. Cross RR Tracks | - |
| 65.7 | R - San Elijo Ave. B/C Manchester Ave. Pass under I-5 ahead. | 2.4 |
| 68.1 | R - To continue on Manchester Ave. | 1.6 |
| 69.7 | S - Near Olivenhain, road B/C Rancho Santa Fe Rd. | 2.7 |
| 72.4 | BR - To continue on Rancho Santa Fe Rd | 2.6 |
| 75 | R - San Elijo Rd. Pass through San Elijo town. 3 mile climb ahead. | 3.8 |
| 78.8 | S - At top of climb, road B/C S Twin Oaks Valley Rd. (<i>Fast downhill</i>) | 1.8 |

| 82 | L - Woodland Pkwy. (<i>Narrow tunnel under Hwy. 78</i>) | 0.3 |
